

WATER WELL CASE STUDY

In the arid landscape of Village Vehro Sharif, life was a daily struggle for Rahima and her four younger sisters, Fahima, Rahila, Saima, and Zarina. With no access to clean water nearby, the sisters would embark on long, arduous journeys each day, trekking for miles under the scorching sun in search of water for their family's basic needs.

Rahima, as the eldest sister, bore the weight of responsibility on her shoulders. She juggled the demands of caring for her younger siblings, managing household chores, and ensuring her elderly parents were looked after, all while grappling with the relentless cycle of water scarcity.

Every drop of water was precious and had to be rationed carefully. The sisters would return home exhausted, their containers heavy with water, only to repeat the journey the next day. With so much time and energy consumed by the quest for water, there was little opportunity for education or personal development.

But then, hope arrived in the form of the Al Hasanaat Foundation. Moved by the plight of the sisters, the foundation took action and installed a water well in their neighbourhood. For the first time in their lives, clean, safe water was readily available right at their doorstep.

The impact was immediate and profound. With the burden of water scarcity lifted, Rahima and her sisters could redirect their time and energy towards their studies and personal growth. The sisters flourished academically, with Rahima serving as a role model for her younger siblings, encouraging them to excel in their studies and pursue higher education. With access to clean water, their health improved, and they were able to lead more active, vibrant lives.

Through the generosity of the Al Hasanaat Foundation, Rahima and her sisters were given the gift of opportunity—the opportunity to break free from the shackles of water scarcity and build a brighter future.



HAFIZ E QURAN/ EDUCATION

The Quran and Sunnah are the foundations of our faith, and we adhere to them in everything we do. Thanks to our charitable donors, we managed to not only deliver the basic necessities but also provided an opportunity to learn and memorise the holy Quran which can set these children on a path to success to both the world.

A three-year program is designed to help children memorise the Quran, alongside other subjects. This sponsorship provides a child with shelter and a chance to attend school, have regular meals and frequent medical check-ups. As the situation in India is worsening, we have recently visited and surveyed that a girl's islamic school is a much needed and priority project. MASJID CASE STUDY

Location: Masjid Al Anwar Imam's Name: Maulana Muhammad Abu Bakr Madani

Role in the Community: I'm the local Imam of our village mosque Masjid Al Anwar, Built by Al Hasanaat Foundation, where I lead prayers and provide spiritual guidance to our community members. The community is really pleased since the mosque has been built.

People of mixed castes living together most of them depend on livestock and small-scale cultivation, some literate men are attached to education at various levels.

Culture: In this village, residents gather for prayers and special occasions at the mosque/community hall where traditional rituals and prayers strengthen their community bonds.

One of the primary vulnerabilities was the lack of access to Islamic teachings and knowledge within the village. Many of our residents were facing challenges when seeking religious education, as travelling to remote areas for this purpose is often unfeasible.

Family: Muhammad Abu Bakr is a father of two children and believes in instilling strong values in them to become responsible members of our community. This response provides insights into the life, role, and experiences of one individual living in a village with a focus on their connection to the community and the impact of the newly built community hall.
